# DreamWeaver – Introductory

---

## Objectives

Upon completion of this course, attendees will be able to use DreamWeaver to create web pages quickly and easily using page layout techniques or HTML code.

## Pre-Requisites

Those attending this course should be familiar with personal computers and be competent in the use of the keyboard and mouse. In addition, those attending should have an appreciation of web browsing and the Internet.

## Duration

2 days

## Course Outcomes

1. Discuss basic Internet and HTML concepts; identify components of the Dreamweaver workspace; edit and format text; and view the HTML code for a Web page.
2. Plan and define a Web site; use Map view and the Assets panel to manage a site; create a Web page; import text from other documents; and modify colours and other page properties.
3. Create paragraphs and basic page structures; insert special characters; format text by applying HTML tags and list formats
4. Create tables to arrange data and control page layout; set row and column properties; format tables; and use layout tables to design pages.
5. Choose appropriate image formats; embed images and set image properties; create appropriate alternate text; and apply background images.
6. Create links to other pages and resources; create named anchors, e-mail links, and image maps; and format links with CSS.
7. Connect to a Web server through a secure FTP connection; check a site for broken links and orphaned files; and upload a site.

## Optional Assessment

**This is a nationally recognised training program.** Participants who successfully complete the optional assessment component of this course will receive a Statement of Attainment for the unit of competency outlined above (additional fee applies). Participants who choose not to be assessed will receive a Certificate of Attendance. The case study assignment is completed in the participant's own time.
