
SIR20207 Certificate II in Retail

Description

This qualification provides the skills and knowledge for an individual to be competent in a range of activities and functions requiring basic retail operational knowledge and limited practical skills in a defined context. Work would be undertaken in various retail store settings, such as specialty stores, supermarkets, department stores and retail fast food outlets. Individuals may work with some autonomy or in a team but usually under close supervision



Job roles and titles vary across different industry sectors. Possible job titles include: sales assistant, customer service representative, crew member, checkout operator.

Qualification Pathways

There are no prerequisites for entry to this qualification.

After achieving the SIR20207 Certificate II in Retail, candidates may undertake the SIR30207 Certificate III in Retail, a qualification for those seeking to develop further practical skills a provides the skills and knowledge for an individual to be competent in retail operations and/or supervision, or other relevant Certificate III qualifications.

Qualification Rules

Total of 14 units comprising:

9 Core units and 3 Elective units from Elective Group A or Elective Group B and 2 Elective units
Maximum of 2 Elective units may be selected from the General Elective Units and/or 2 units from another endorsed Training Package

Training & Recognition of Current Competencies (RCC)

Much of the training is delivered on-the-job through reading, interacting with colleagues and completing useful project work. You only need to attend off-the-job training if a competency cannot be acquired at the workplace.

You may already have many of the skills required to qualify for this qualification. There is no need to be trained in things you can already do. NDA will assess current skills and give recognition for relevant competencies.
