
SIR30207 Certificate III in Retail

Description

This qualification provides the skills and knowledge for an individual to be competent in retail operations and/or supervision with the need to apply discretion and judgement. Work would be undertaken in various retail store settings, such as specialty stores, supermarkets, department stores and retail fast food outlets. Individuals may have some responsibility for others and provide or hold specific coordination or support responsibilities within a store team.



Job roles and titles vary across different industry sectors. Possible job titles include: sales assistant, customer service representative, crew leader, shift manager, team leader, department manager, assistant store manager, checkout supervisor, merchandise coordinator.

Qualification Pathways

There are two alternative pathways for entry into the Certificate III in Retail. The candidate must either:

1. Be recognised as competent, through a recognised training program or recognition process, against the following units of competency:

2. Have sufficient relevant retail employment experience. A current or previous job role that involves or has involved the application of the above competencies would be a satisfactory indicator for entry. A determination need not involve a formal process of measuring, evaluating or recording performance against the units of competency. Examples of evidence to support a determination could include: job descriptions and references from current or past employers; or an entry interview to determine what competencies have been applied in the retail environment in a paid or voluntary capacity.

After achieving the SIR30207 Certificate III in Retail, candidates may undertake the SIR40207 Certificate IV in Retail Management; a qualification for those seeking to develop skills and knowledge in first line management in retail or wholesale industries, or other relevant Certificate IV qualifications.

Qualification Rules

Total of 10 units comprising:

3 Core units: Core: Group A or Core: Group B and 7 Elective units between 5 and 7 Elective units must be selected from the Elective Units and a Maximum of 2 Electives may be selected from the Product Knowledge functional category.

Training & Recognition of Current Competencies (RCC)

Much of the training is delivered on-the-job through reading, interacting with colleagues and completing useful project work. You only need to attend off-the-job training if a competency cannot be acquired at the workplace.

You may already have many of the skills required to qualify for this qualification. There is no need to be trained in things you can already do. NDA will assess current skills and give recognition for relevant competencies.
