BSBCRT511 - Develop critical thinking in others

Course Objectives

This course describes the skills and knowledge required to develop critical and creative thinking skills in others within a workplace context.

It applies to individuals who are developing and coaching others, for whom critical thinking skills (including analysis, synthesis, and evaluation) are an important part of their job roles. This unit applies to individuals who are typically responsible for leading teams.

Learning Outcomes

Assess individual and team critical and creative thinking skills

- Research models of critical and creative thinking
- Develop questions to identify individual and team knowledge gaps
- Facilitate formal and informal learning opportunities for addressing identified gaps
- Articulate key features of critical and creative thinking concepts to relevant personnel

Establish an environment that encourages critical and creative thinking

- Analyse current organisational systems to identify gaps or barriers
- Develop processes that create a safe environment for critical and creative thinking approaches

- Facilitate opportunities for team members to apply critical thinking skills to workplace problems
- Provide feedback to team members on performance of tasks

Monitor and improve thinking practices

- Collect and analyse feedback from individuals and teams on critical and creative thinking opportunities
- Identify additional support required for teams and individuals
- Develop recommendations for improvements in future learning arrangements according to relevant legislation and organisation policies

Optional Assessment - \$195 per unit
