TAE40122 – Certificate IV in Training and Assessment

The TAE40122 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment reflects the roles of individuals delivering training and assessment services in the vocational education and training (VET) sector.

Entry Requirements

Those entering this program must be able to demonstrate vocational competency in their proposed teaching and assessing area. Vocational competency is defined as broad industry knowledge and experience, and may include, but is not limited to, holding a relevant unit of competency or qualification. NDA strongly recommends learners to have the following requirements outlined below:

- Have access to a computer (with Adobe Reader, Microsoft Word and Google)
- Have a reasonable level of language, literacy and numeracy skills
- Have an intermediate level of technology skills

Examples of job roles for learners wanting to undertake this qualification may include, but are not limited to: Trainer, Enterprise Trainer and Assessor, Learning Product Developer, Assessor (Training), Enterprise Trainer.

Volume of learning

The Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) volume of Learning Indicators, provide a starting point for the amount of training provided for a qualification at an AQF Level (4) Certificate, and states the following volume of Learning:

Certificate IV 0.5-2 years approximately 600-2400 hours*

*This indicator is designed to be a starting point only and many factors can affect the amount of training required.

You are given 12 months to complete the Certificate IV in Training and Assessment qualification. Extensions for qualification completion are available upon request to our RTO Administrator where learners can supply sufficient reasoning or alternatively you may complete the qualification early. Additional fees may apply.

Suspensions, extensions and cancellations

Training courses

TAE40122 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment units

• 2 units may be from any other from any currently endorsed Training Package or accredited course at Certificate III or above (with a maximum of 1 at Level III).

How is the qualification delivered?



Face to Face Classroom Sessions

The face-to-face classroom sessions are training courses that have been developed to directly align to specific units in the qualification. This delivery method is undertaken in conjunction with self-paced study.

Training Delivery Session: Learners will attend three days following delivery of the classroom training sessions to undergo assessment. Participants will be required to deliver a Training Session (3 x 30m) to the group.	Cluster 4 Assessment Days	3 days (consecutive)

How is the qualification assessed?

To achieve this qualification learners are required to be found Competent in 12 units of competency. The following methods are used to gather evidence of competence.

The training plan completed upon induction outlines the training and assessment methods for each unit of competency. The induction will be carried out during the first day of training.

NDA TAE Course

- 1. Cluster one 'Learning Design' covering the units listed in the previous table.
- 2. Cluster two 'Training Delivery' covering the units listed in the previous table.
- 3. Cluster three 'Assessment' covering the units listed in the previous table.
- 4. Cluster four Work-based delivery / assessment:

Upon completion of session three, participants will attend a three-day training and assessment session.

Following successful completion of the entire TAE Activity Book, plus observations of participant delivering training and assessing competence as listed, the participants shall be deemed competent in all units listed above.

RPL Portfolio

Learners may submit a portfolio of recognition of prior learning (RPL) evidence to the assessor for assessment relevant to the unit of competency.

*There may be an additional cost for this service, depending on the volume of work required by the trainer.

Payment

Fees charged by NDA include all resources, training and assessment services *including* attendance at *relevant NDA training courses*.

User Choice Funded

The TAE qualifications is partially funded under the Department of State Growth User Choice Funding scheme for eligible participants, however, there is a gap fee payable of \$2,500. The employer contribution is invoiced as follows:
